




Threats and Challenges:

- Local Authorities limited budgets
- Interconnectivity between areas
- Introduction of cycling/ walking for older vulnerable road users may involve mobility challenges
- Required separation from traffic and pedestrian crossings

- In the UK, there is no central document detailing needs and requirements for Older Road Users

Recommendations:

- High level recommendation is that the DfT should consider combining the design guidance for infrastructure for older road users along the lines already in place in the USA, Australia and New Zealand
- Ensure signs are conspicuous
- Consider design of footways and kerbs for mobility scooters
- Pedestrian crossing improvements
